- Board Member Lee Bunting Represented BBLA at the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Philadelphia District 4/12 Public Meeting
- Explanation provided on repair of a failed section of bulkhead/revetment along the interior north shoreline of the Indian River Inlet
- "Sand tightening" being done on a 215-foot section of the south jetty - work involves installing steel sheet piling to reduce the amount of sand migrating into the inlet
- USACE & DNREC coordinating vehicular/pedestrian/trailer access to the inlet area at Delaware Seashore State Park
- Park operations will be affected for the duration of the project





Update on Dredging Project for White Creek & Assawoman Canal


- White Creek Navigation Channel (northwest of BB) last dredged approx 25 yrs ago


