DE Statewide Ban In Effect on All Open Burning

- Issued on 10/15 by DE State Fire Marshall
- In effect until further notice
- Very dry conditions below-average precipitation since late summer
- Record low rainfall in New Castle and Sussex Counties
- The ban includes:
- --Controlled burning of yard/garden material (excluding leaves, which are never permitted)
- --Bonfires
- -- Demolition burning
- --Prescribed burns for land management
- --Agricultural burning for field maintenance




