- RETURN DAY is a tradition in Sussex County for over 200 years
- State Law in 1791 removed the County seat from Lewes along the Coast to the more geographically centered site - later named Georgetown
- The law required all votes to be cast in the new County Seat on election



- Jane Gruenbaum (D-District 3) defeated incumbent Republican Mark Schaeffer (Lewes) in the general election
- Bethany Beach is located in District 4 represented by Doug Hudson
