- The new Mobi-mats are appreciated by beachgoers - thanks to the Town for a durable investment
- Beach clock is undergoing its repairs - expected to be back in its place of honor on the boardwalk towards the end of July
- Four more porta-potties to be installed in June on beach streets
 - Second Street
 - Central Boulevard
 - Maplewood Street
 - Cedarwood Street
- Public restroom redesign will occur in the Fall 2019
- "Beach Wardens" have been employed to monitor adherence to beach regulations - staying off the dunes, etc.
- Stay tuned for July 4th Fireworks location announcement - a wide beach area is necessary

Off the Beach News

- Collins Street pedestrian path project has been delayed due to the contract bidding process
- Redesign of South Atlantic Avenue is complete
- Cedarwood Street has been repaved - no on-street parking is allowed
- Construction of the new "Central Park" (southwest side of Garfield Parkway) will begin on June 17th o plantings will occur in the fall o an open octagon pavillion will be included o completion of the project projected for early winter
